- ✓ Vendor spaces are \$10.00 for each 10 x 10 space and are on a first come basis. All vendors must provide their own tents, tables, and chairs. Vendor fees will start to be collected around

10:00am. Cash only.

- o All tents must be secured and weighted with at least 100 lbs.
- Vendor set up time starts at 5:30am. Come early for the best spot. NO vehicles will be allowed on the field for set up after 7:00am.
- All unloading vehicles that are not parked around the perimeter MUST be off the field by 7am.
- ✓ The Market will be held every 2nd and 4th Saturday from May through October.
- ✓ The Placitas Seller's Open-Air Holiday Market takes place in the month of November
- √ No food, beverages or firearms can be sold.
- ✓ Leashed dogs are welcomed.
- ✓ There is no ATM close by.
- ✓ Restroom facilities are available onsite.
